DIAGNOSTICIAN/INTERVENTIONIST (HPC/ALH 3)

The Board of Management of Church Teachers' College invites applications from suitably qualified individuals to fill the position of Diagnostician/Interventionist (Special Education) within its Educational Assessment & Intervention Centre.

Job Summary:

To support the diagnostic and therapeutic process for children with special needs through comprehensive academic assessments, intervention planning, training, public education and collaborative case management. The Diagnostician/Interventionist plays a key role in conducting educational assessments, interpreting relevant data and developing learning and teaching strategies designed to address particular social, behavioural and/or academic needs experienced by children within the educational system.

Key Responsibilities

- Conducting comprehensive academic assessments for children referred to the Centre.
- Providing remedial instruction to students enrolled in the intervention programmes.
- Engaging in prescriptive teaching utilizing a variety of empirical strategies aligned to student growth and addressing academic weaknesses.
- Engaging in appropriate planning and preparation of appropriate work materials suitable for addressing academic deficits.
- Providing guidance to parents and teachers in the interest of the child's intellectual growth and development (e.g. discussing suitable recommendations)
- Serving as a member of the Individual Intervention Plan (IIP) team to support provision of high-quality remedial services.
- Conducting workshops and seminars for parents, teachers, principals, education officers, community partners, etc on matters related to special education.
- Supporting the Centre's professional development and public education agenda through the development of articles and other public education content/materials.
- Engages in research projects and initiatives undertaken by the Centre.
- Keeps abreast of the latest developments in the field of Special Education

Minimum Qualifications & Experience

- Master's Degree in Special Education – Major: Learning Disabilities/Intellectual Disabilities/Behavioural Disorders/Dyslexia
- Five years Clinical (assessment) experience
- Three years experience working in a remedial setting would be an asset
